

RING SIZE GUIDE


- 1. Before printing, set page scaling to "None" on your printer's settings.
- 2. Once printed, measure the bar below with a ruler ensuring it is exactly 6 inches in length.



A. Find Your Ring Size Using an Existing Ring

- 1. Choose a ring that already fits the finger you want to size.
- 2. Place it over the circles on the chart and match the inside edge of the ring with the circle that fits best.
- 3. If your ring falls between two sizes, go for the quarter size in between.

Example: If it's between Size 5 and 5.5, pick Size 5.25.



B. Measure Your Finger with the Cutout Sizer

- 1. Carefully cut out the finger sizer along the outline and make a small slit where marked.
- 2. Wrap the strip around the finger you want to measure.
- 3. Insert the pointed end through the slit with the numbers facing outward.
- 4. Gently tighten until it fits snugly.
- 5. The number visible at the slit will be your ring size.
